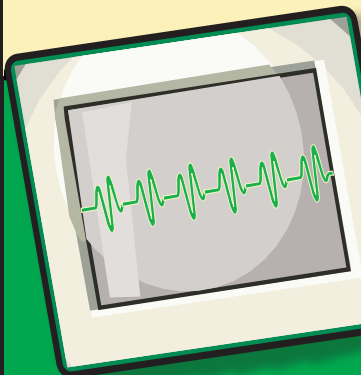
## Emergency Department

## Allied Health

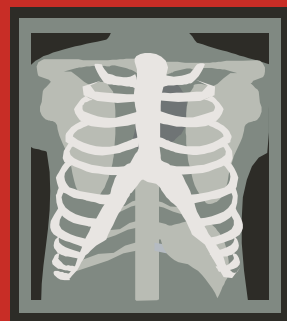

Examines patients with X-rays.

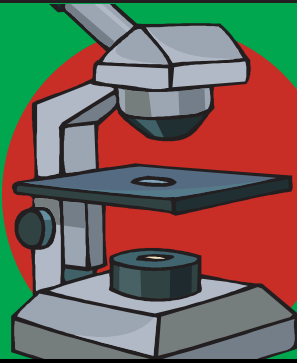

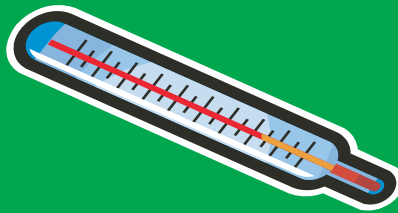
blood to show how a patient is responding to treatment.
